

EMERGENCY AFTER HOURS

Review this information to determine what type of emergency you have and what to do about it!

Fosters are **NOT ALLOWED** to take their foster animals to a clinic unless approved by us.

Things that DON'T REQUIRE calling the emergency line and can be emailed to the foster team:



- Hot Spot/Rash
- Coughing/Sneezing
- Nasal Discharge
- Single episode of vomiting
- Dirty Ears
- Visible worms in stool
- New limp
- Fleas/Ticks
- Watery eyes
- Broken nail
- Blood in stool
- Trouble urinating
- Blood in urine
- Diarrhea
- Lethargy

Things that WOULD REQUIRE calling the emergency line at (352) 577-9119:



- Incident of aggression where the animals or person is hurt.
- Open/Bleeding wound that would require sutures
- Severe trauma
- Lost animal
- Ingestion of toxic substance
- Difficulty breathing/choking
- Seizure
- Profusely bleeding
- Hit by a car/serious injury
- Unable to stand or walk
- Unresponsive
- Vomiting nonstop
